School Day

Hours and Operations:

District Calendar 184 student days (4 emergency days included) Arrival and drop-off begins: at 8:40 am

Dismissal and pick up begins at 3:00 pm

Is it important for students to be on time? Yes.

Morning Arrival

- Morning drop off will begin at 8:40am in the Front Circle.
- We will stagger the buses and cars so that there is no intermingling.
- THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO PASSING ANY CARS OR BUSES IN FRONT OF YOU.
- We will utilize all of the space in the front circle for arrival so please pull forward to the next available staff member.
- Cones will be located near each drop off door.
- <u>Students must exit the car on the right</u> side. (curbside)
- Please do not drop children off before 8:40 a.m. unless they are enrolled in the Sunrise/Sunset program; school doors will not open until 8:40 a.m.



Dismissal

- Afternoon Dismissal will begin at 3:00 p.m.
- Parking is available in the lower parking lot. Please walk up to the correct location and stand behind the outdoor cones. If there are cones blocking a space, please do not move the cones to park.
 - **<u>Pre-K and Kindergarten</u>** students will dismiss from the far door near the loading dock.
 - **First grade and second grade** students will be dismissed from the double doors near the first grade playground. Please leave promptly after picking up your child to ensure parking for other families.

• The playground will be off-limits during dismissal.

• Students riding buses will begin dismissal at 2:58pm.



Classroom Assistants

In addition to our classroom teachers, each Kindergarten Class has a part-time teaching assistant. Teaching assistants provide academic support to all students in the classroom.

Breakfast & Lunch

Breakfast and lunch will be served daily at school.

All families must still complete a lunch application.

Students are encouraged to bring in a healthy snack for the morning or afternoon.

Recess

Kindergarten students receive a recess period before or after lunch. Lunch assistants monitor students during recess and lunch.

Teaching and learning is designed to engage students in critical thinking, discovery/inquiry, and investigation experiences.


Ready Mathematics and i-Ready resources are utilized during instruction and learning.





K-5 report cards are *Standards-Based* and aligned to trimester reporting periods and provide feedback on student achievement toward learning standards.

The report cards for the first two trimesters align with Parent Teacher Conferences and do not include a narrative.

Bilingual Education

The WIDA English Language Acquisition Placement Test will be administered to students based on the responses of the Home Language Survey.

Students qualifying for bilingual education will receive instruction in English and Spanish and as a part of our biliteracy design.
